WHAT IS DISCOVERY?



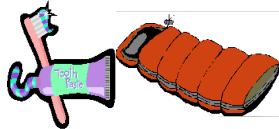
Discovery

What to Bring

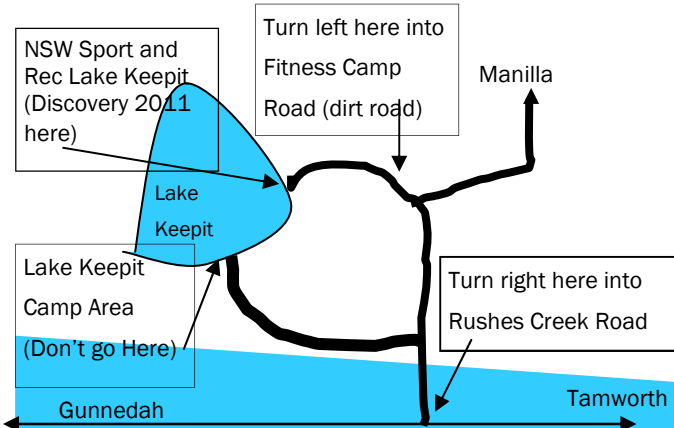
